## MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF THE LONG BEACH WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT April 10, 2019

A special meeting was convened to further discuss the proposal submitted by Utility Partners/City of Long Beach Public Works Department for the purposes of providing maintenance "as needed" for Canal No. 1 and Canal 2/3 in the Long Beach Water Management District.

A discussion was held with regard to the details provided in the proposal which set forth routine maintenance and the equipment necessary for same, as well as routine operations for general maintenance.

Additionally, further discussions were held examining the items listed as additional services in the proposal. Upon Motion duly made by Commissioner Ladner, seconded by Commissioner Marshall, and unanimously carried, the Commissioners approved that an Interlocal Agreement be drafted by and between the City of Long Beach and the Long Beach Water Management District for review and consideration for canal maintenance services to be performed by the City of Long Beach for Canal No. 1 and Canal 2/3.
